If you're looking for a place to meet your friends or neighbors for Sunday breakfast/ brunch, consider the Mar Vista Farmers Market. You'll find a selection of food booths with great offerings. Café Laurent prepares wonderful omelets. Ham, turkey, avocado, mushroom, Swiss cheese or chorizo, tomatoes, caramelized onion, cheese are just two of the omelets you can choose from.

Larry's Grill offers tacos, quesadillas, empanadas and tostadas. At Dray's Bar-B-Que Co. you'll find barbecued chicken, pulled pork, free-range grass-fed leg of lamb, trip tip sandwiches and Cajun chicken links. All are served with a side of beans and potato salad. The Hungry Inka serves Peruvian rice: shrimp and chicken, vegetarian or chicken with broccoli.

Nana's Chips & Salsa sells tamales: pork or chicken. Or choose one of Nana's burritos filled with grilled chicken, carne asada, vegetables or soy chorizo. For simpler fare, you can buy a baguette, cheeses, apples, pears and grapes. Don't forget your coffee and fresh orange juice.

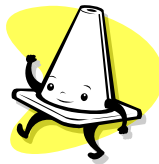

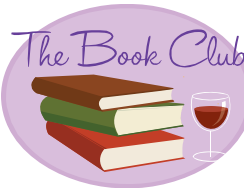

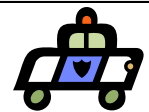
